RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The American Legion Riders Department of California Bylaws Article XIV, Section 1 currently reads, *“The American Legion Riders Department of California may place on probation or revoke the Charter of any Chapter of The American Legion Riders - Department of California that violates the Constitution or Bylaws of this Department, subject to the approval of the Department Executive Committee”*; and

WHEREAS, Under this Bylaw, approval for placing a Chapter on probation must be approved by the American Legion Riders Department of California Executive Committee; and

WHEREAS, Waiting for approval of the Department Executive Committee for such an action to be taken causes an unnecessary delay to the action; and

WHEREAS, Probation is considered to be an administrative action separate from suspension or other more serious punitive actions; and

WHEREAS, Probation only results in a Chapter losing its right to participate in the American Legion Riders Department Convention which is done automatically and is automatically reversed when all Department obligations are met under the American Legion Riders Department of California Bylaws; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion Riders is a program of The American Legion making is subject to The Bylaws of The American Legion now therefore be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion Riders Department of California at the Department Convention in Norco, California, on April 18-19, 2026, that the Department of California American Legion Riders Bylaws Article XIV Section 1.b be changed to read, “Any Chapter not complying with the provisions of Article V Section 6, Article VII Section 2 and 3, and Article X Section 2 of the Bylaws of the American Legion Riders Department of California shall be placed on Administrative Probation and not accreditable for the Department Convention until all requirements are met. Notification of any action under this Section shall be sent to both the Chapter involved and its respective Area Vice Director.”
