RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, In the American Legion Riders Department of California Bylaws Article IV, Section 1., the first sentence states, “The elected officers of this organization shall be the Director, Vice- Director, Sergeant-at-Arms, and six (6) Area Vice-Directors. The appointed officers shall be the Judge Advocate, Secretary, Treasurer, and Chaplain, Historian, Service Officer, Safety Officer, Quartermaster, Membership Officer and Parliamentarian.”

WHEREAS, The American Legion Riders Department of California website is an integral part of the function of the Riders of California; and

WHEREAS, The Webmaster is critical to the function of the Department Website which helps in keeping the Department running properly including, but not limited to having the Chapters maintain their responsibilities to the Department Bylaws; and

WHEREAS, There needs to be a description of the responsibilities of the Webmaster in the Department Bylaws; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion Riders Department of California at the Department Convention in Norco, California, on April 18-19, 2026, that the first sentence of the Department of California American Legion Riders Bylaws Article IV, Section 1, be changed to read, “*The elected officers of this organization shall be the Director, Vice- Director, Sergeant-at-Arms, and six (6) Area Vice-Directors. The appointed officers shall be the Judge Advocate, Secretary, Treasurer, and Chaplain, Historian, Service Officer, Safety Officer, Quartermaster, Membership Officer, Parliamentarian, and Webmaster.*”; and be it further

RESOLVED, That a new Section 16 be added to the same Article to state, Section 16.

***WEBMASTER: The Webmaster shall maintain and administer the official website, online platforms, and digital communication tools of the American Legion Riders – Department of California. The Webmaster shall ensure timely publication of official notices, announcements, and information authorized by the Department Director or Department Executive Committee. The Webmaster shall coordinate with the Secretary, Historian, and Membership Officer to maintain accurate, accessible, and secure digital records and information. The Webmaster shall also perform such other duties as assigned by the Director, provided there is no conflict with these Bylaws.*”; and be it finally**

RESOLVED the current Section 16 be renumbered to Section 17.
